[Acts 3.1-11]

THIS MIRACLE

- Demonstrates the first principle of God's work – that we usually begin by seeking far less than God wants to give us (v. 3).
- Demonstrates the second principle of God's work – that divine power comes in the act of faith, not before (v. 7-8).
- Demonstrates that the Messiah had come (v. 8; Isaiah 35.6).
- Demonstrates that God uses lives that have been changed to draw others to hear the Gospel (v. 11).

PETER PREACHES JESUS

- As Incarnated Christ (v. 13)
- As Servant (v.12)
- As Holy and Righteous One (v. 14)
- As Author of Life (v. 15)

[Acts 3.17-26]

GOSPEL RESPONSE

- Repent (v. 19a)
- Faith (v. 19; Ephesians 2.8-9)

GOSPEL PROMISE

- He promises your sins will be wiped out (v.19b; Isaiah 43.25).
- He promises times of refreshing will come (v. 20, 26).
- He promises that Jesus will return to restore everything as He had promised (v. 20-21).
